## **Dear Parents**

The in-term swimming lessons are considered essential for all children and, as such, the school encourages all to participate. This term the next round of lessons involves students in Pre-Primary plus Years 1 & 6. Lessons will begin <u>Wednesday</u> <u>October 15, 2025</u> (8-day series). Classes will be transported by bus. To ensure adequate supervision of your child, the Education Department now requires that if your child has been observed, or is otherwise known, to be subject to any form of medical condition involving periodic loss of consciousness, the child should not be permitted to swim unless a medical certificate is produced by you, the parent, stating it is safe to do so, AND additional supervision is to be arranged making it safe for the child to do so. It would be appreciated, if your child fits into this category, that you act on this immediately. Please contact the school to discuss any arrangements that may be necessary or send in the medical certificate before the first lessons. Unless such conditions are listed and the form returned, swimming staff will hold no responsibility for medical conditions of which they are not aware.

The swimming lessons Coordinator would appreciate if all parents could complete and return by <u>Wednesday September 24</u>, the form below that will ensure accurate placement of your child. Please note that medical certificates are normally valid for twelve (12) months. <u>Diabetics</u> need no medical certificate unless additional supervision is required. <u>Children with asthma or anaphylaxis must bring their medication to every swimming lesson</u>.

Children may wear their bathers under their school uniform but don't forget to pack underwear for them to put on after their lessons. They will also need to bring a rashie, towel, thongs (to wear to & from the pool) and goggles if they need them. Please make sure that **all items are labelled** with their name.
